- Clothing (several changes of exercise clothing is a popular choice)
- Rubber-soled shoes
- Bathrobe and slippers
- Nightgown/pajamas
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, etc
- Personal hygiene items such as shaving equipment, hair brush and make-up
- Glasses and/or hearing aids
- Assistive devices such as a walker

We encourage you to bring items that will make your stay with us comfortable. Please refrain from bringing expensive or irreplaceable items such as jewelry or large sums of money.

Family and/or friends will need to launder your clothing for you while you are with us.

May I Have Visitors?

Visits from family and friends are encouraged, and their participation in your treatment and educational program is recommended.

We respectfully request that visitors not interrupt your treatment schedule or rest breaks. We want you to receive the maximum benefit from the program.
